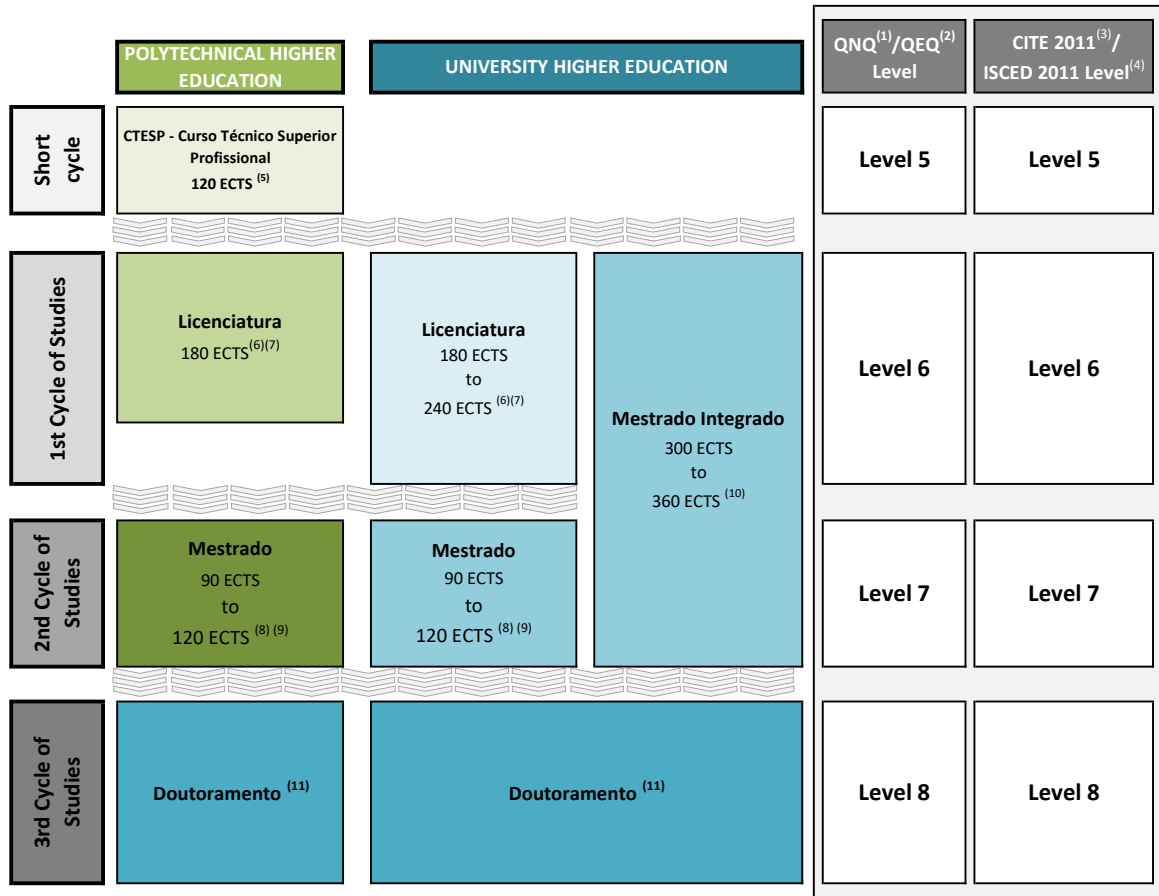


## Portuguese Higher Education System

<sup>(9)</sup> The "Mestre" degree is granted.

<sup>(10)</sup> In some specific fields, a Mestre degree may also be granted following an integrated cycle of studies. In such cases,

a Licenciado degree is granted to students having obtained 180 ECTS (3 years, 6 semesters).
